

This renovation of Skinny Raven's downtown location will create a new and efficient floorplan for retail operations and a new and pleasing aesthetic.



This new building is being built to accommodate the growing law firm. Robert Stone is currently at 1049 W 5th Ave. but will soon be moving into this attractive two-story building.



FAA ANC Air Taffic Control Tower & TRACON Building

The new airport traffic control tower (ATCT) and terminal radar approach control base building (TRACON) in Anchorage will provide air traffic control for ANC. When complete, the ATCT will be a feat of structural engineering and the **tallest structure in Alaska** at more than 300 feet tall, nearly twice as tall as the existing tower. Clad with a durable metal panel rainscreen, the 12-sided cab will improve technology and viewing to control aircraft movements. The design addresses overcrowding, incorporating additional space for supervisory and support staff, as well as National Air Traffic Controllers Association representatives.





ECI + Cornerstone

Aquarian Charter School Renovation

Upgrades to the school include new siding, windows and doors, code required structural upgrades, a new HVAC system, boiler upgrades, new interior lighting, new ADA compliant ramps, sidewalks, and Title 21 compliance, plumbing repairs in support of the new HVAC system and interior upgrades as well as renovation of mechanical, electrical and system controls. Work includes demolition, renovation and new construction features.

ConocoPhillips Atrium & Café Remodel

The project includes a full remodel of the existing ConocoPhillips building atrium located at 700 G Street and level 1 common area of the ANO Tower. The updates will include the addition of a coffee area, seating podium to include a variety of casual seating environments, a property manager's office, a new digital gallery area and new vending area. Artwork will be incorporated into the atrium area in lieu of the existing water feature.

CIHA Ch'bala Corners Multi-Family Housing Phase 2

This development is the second phase of an urban infill and restoration project in Anchorage's Spenard neighborhood. The development includes three Garden Apartment buildings with twenty-four two-bedroom units along Fish Creek. Along 36th Avenue, the project provides three Townhouse buildings with a total of twelve three-bedroom units. The site is located at the intersection of Spenard Road and 36th Avenue.

NorthForm Architecture + Dawson

Prince William Sound Science Center

This research facility project is being completed in two phases:


Phase 1: interior and building shell, completed in June of 2022

Phase 2: seawater intake and outfall system, Spring 2023

The seawater system provides filtered seawater to support live aquatic specimens and provides flow for a heat pump system to provide free heating and cooling for the building.

Alutiiq Museum Renovation & Expansion

The project consists of the expansion and renovation of the existing Alutiiq Museum building. The scope of the design includes a 4,100 square foot addition to the existing building including a new exterior plaza, new entry lobby space, expanded gallery, new community gathering spaces, interior renovations of existing spaces, and building-wide mechanical and electrical upgrades. Breaking ground in June 2023.

Seward Animal Shelter

This project used modular construction and the new facility replaced the City of Seward's make-shift outdoor animal shelter. Completed in October, this public project was designed, permitted, and constructed in one year.





Survey Question: What are some of the major factors which are likely to influence cost of construction in 2023?







Survey Question: How much cost or schedule flexibility should Building Owners consider for your specific trades?



Survey Question: How busy are you looking in 2023?





Changes in the Cost of Construction in 2023 Input Indices


